



School Uniform

All pupils up to Form 5 are expected to wear the school uniform correctly at all times. Any student who does not comply will be required to inform their form tutor via a note from parents, as well as undertaking to fix the problem within a reasonable time limit.

Uniform is not compulsory in the sixth form but students must dress with decorum. On Wednesdays uniform is optional for Form 4 and Form 5.

To avoid the loss of articles of clothing, please ensure that all garments are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Nursery Uniform

- Regulation tracksuit
- Regulation white polo shirt
- Navy blue shorts in the summer (optional)
- Training shoes

Reception to Junior 2

- Regulation navy blue jumper
- Regulation white polo shirt
- Grey skirt or trousers
- Black leather shoes (not trainers)

Junior 3 to Form 5

Winter Uniform *(worn from October Half Term to Easter Holidays)*

- Regulation navy blue blazer (optional)
- Regulation navy blue jumper with regulation school crest
- Long-sleeved plain white shirt with collar
- Regulation school tie
- Plain grey school-type skirt or school-type trousers (no pinstripes or jeans)
- Black leather shoes (not trainers or shoes made by sports brands)
- Plain, dark (black, grey or navy) socks or tights (not leggings)

In wintertime, students can add layers for warmth: their jumper over their shirt; then their blazer. When outdoors, they can wear an overcoat (preferably dark-coloured).

Summer Uniform *(optional from Easter Holidays to October Half Term)*

- Regulation white polo shirt with regulation school crest
- Grey skirt, trousers or tailored shorts
- Regulation navy blue jumper as above (optional)
- Shoes and socks as above



PE Uniform

- Regulation white t-shirt (not regulation white polo shirt)
- Navy blue/black shorts (appropriate length, no denim)
- Regulation navy blue jumper (may be worn in the winter)
- Navy blue sports trousers/leggings (may be worn in the winter)
- Regulation tracksuit
- Training shoes

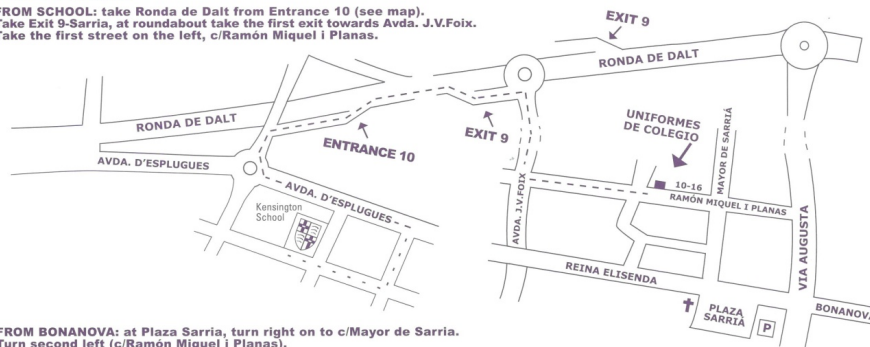
